

QHSSE Advisor

Field based position (Offshore)

The QHSSE Advisor reports directly to the Party Manager (+ Senior QHSSE Advisor as applicable) and functionally reports to the Hemisphere HSSE Manager. He/She advises and assists the Party Manager in planning and managing the QHSSE aspects of the project. He/She also supports and assists the crew and project line management in the sustained implementation and verification of SBGS's OMS, QHSSE standards and procedures as well as adherence to these through training, technical assistance and monitoring. He/She promotes a consistent QHSSE awareness throughout the crew. He/She continually communicates with and informs the functional manager on all QHSSE aspects of the project both on and offsite, including the QHSSE department arrangements. Seeks assistance and guidance from the functional manager on the SBGS Operating Management System (OMS).

Responsibilities include

- Act as a focal point for all crew/project QHSSE matters at the project field level.
- Remain present and visible through the project operations – visiting all aspects of the project.
- Organize and record HSSE training for project personnel including subcontractors, and organize refresher or update courses. Liaise with the SBGS Training & Competence Coordinator.
- Ensure that the site documentation (Project Execution Plan – PEP) is maintained, updated and revised accordingly. Monitor the adherence to the PEP as well as the availability of the resources defined in the PEP.
- Actively participate in briefings and de-briefings of QHSSE stand-downs, drills, and other operational activities, etc.
- Advise Party Manager on the compliance with the local QHSSE programs and with local, national and international regulations as well as industry guidelines.
- Participates in liaising with contractors, clients and local agencies regarding QHSSE.
- Monitor and maintain the project specific Hazard Register.
- Support the crew in managing risk (e.g. Task Risk Assessments (TRA), Management of Change (MOC), and Project Risk Assessments (PRA)).
- Assist in creating and ensuring the adequacy of the project Emergency Response Plan (ERP).
- Attend pre-survey/kick-off/close-out meetings with Clients as and when required.
- Report on the progress of action points and ensure they are tracked to closure.
- Participate in event analysis (HiPo's, significant events, recordable, etc.).
- Review project QHSSE performance indicators and monitors performance against Objectives.
- Assist with the crew QHSSE committee meetings, in capturing and compiling the Lessons Learned in the project Issue Tracker and in compiling the required QHSSE reports (daily, weekly, monthly, etc).
- Assist Quality Manager in promoting culture of continuous improvement, conformance and effectiveness, quality initiatives and quality event reporting.

Qualifications, education & experience requirements

- NEBOSH certificate or a Quality or HSE related university degree or past industry experience as a field based HSSE Advisor.
- Previous experience in seismic operations and/or maritime environment is desired.
- A minimum of 3 years in a field based position.
- Good knowledge of industry (oil & gas, seismic) standards, guidelines and best practices.
- Familiar with the various global, federal and state legislation, standards, regulations, etc., on safety and environmental responsibilities.
- Excellent communication skills with proven leadership capabilities

Travel Requirements

- Frequent and worldwide, sometimes on short notice.
- Travel by airplane, helicopter, and small boat as required.
